CIDA MEMBERSHIP MINUTES

JULY 13, 2009

The meeting was brought to order by President Christy Chester. The treasurer's report was presented and approved. Maria stated we have a total of \$13,443.97 in the bank as of June 30, 2009.

August Clean Up – Sgt. Schriver stated that businesses in our area need to identify the bad spots and we would assign people there to clean it up. Pat Murfey will be getting out a notice of the event later.

12th St. Viaduct - Darby Trotter stated because of our letters to the city especially the one Christy sent, the move to open 12th Street Viaduct three weeks earlier was made. Christy thanked Scott Brown for putting the letter together. Scott also stated that demolition should start on Forrester in late October.

Darby Trotter talked about the \$75,000 PIAC. He wrote a proposal to use as matching funds. The city has not said no but Darby encouraged us to make applications for the money. Also, Monty Summers will get a bid on graffiti being taken off of city buildings. Darby has noted that the city has already taken care of this.

Monty Summers would like to make a motion to have the CIDA pay for a dumpster every once in a while. Tom Roberts stated that a little one by Monty's place would be good for our cleanup day. Monty made the motion and Chris Boland seconded. The vote passed to pay one time for the dumpster to used for the clean up.

Christy Chester stated that the West Bottoms was loosing American Compressed Steel.

The meeting was adjourned.
